



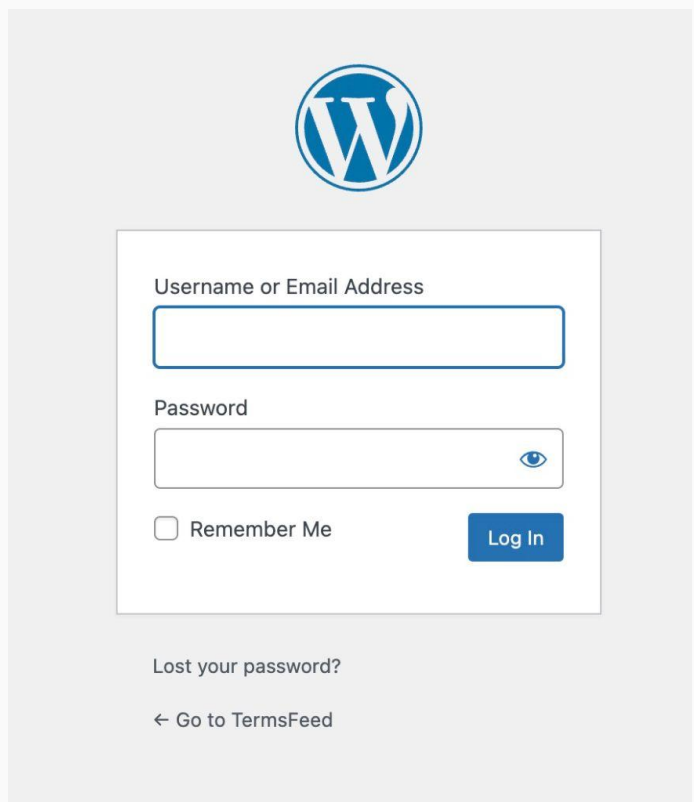
How to Add an "I Agree to Terms & Conditions" Checkbox on

WooCommerce Checkout Page

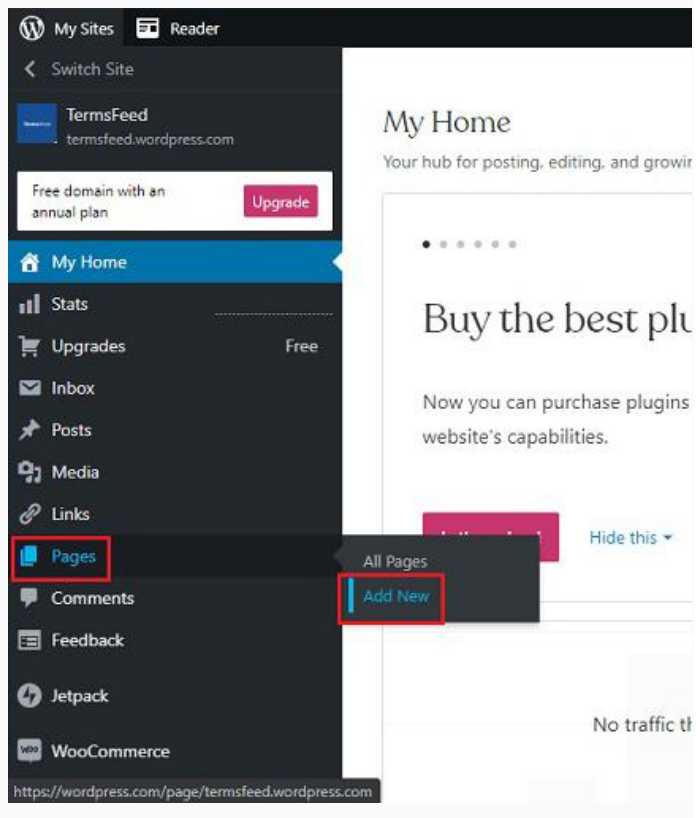


Steps:

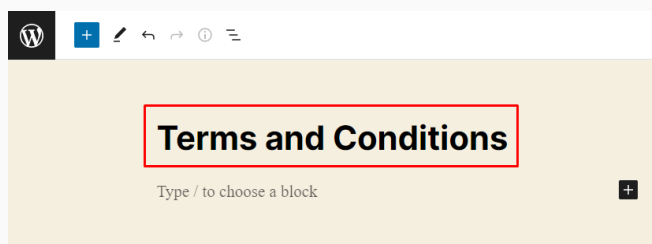
1. **Log in** to your WordPress site.



2. On the Dashboard Menu go to **Pages** and choose **Add New**:

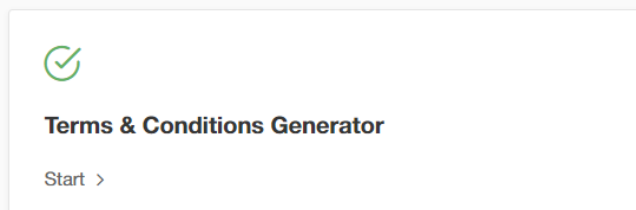


- When the page editor opens, type **"Terms and Conditions"** in the title field:

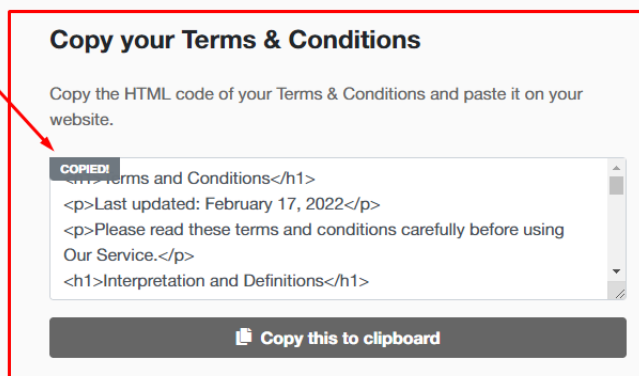


- Now you need to add text to your Terms and Conditions page.

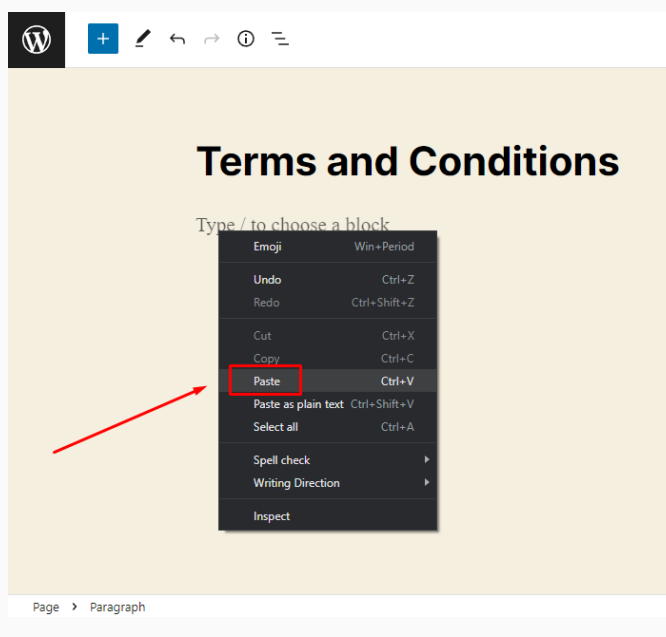
If you do not have a Terms and Conditions, you can use our [Terms and Conditions Generator](#) and create it within minutes.



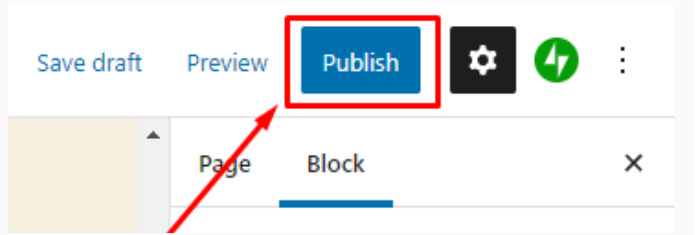
- Go to our **TermsFeed generators** app and log in. In the header menu, choose **"Agreements & Policies"** and on your Terms and Conditions card click the **Download** button.
- On the download page, scroll to the **"Copy your Terms and Conditions"** section and click on the **"Copy this to clipboard"** button:



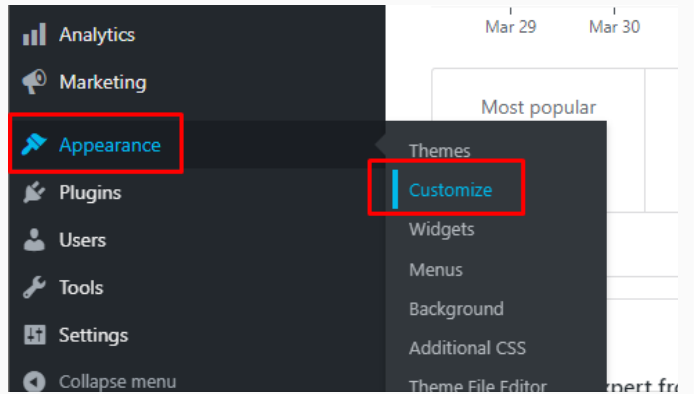
- Next, **go back** to the page editor and **paste the text**:



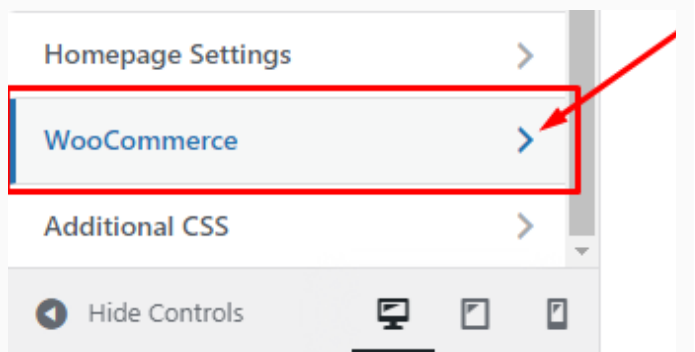
8. When finished, click **Publish** (twice).



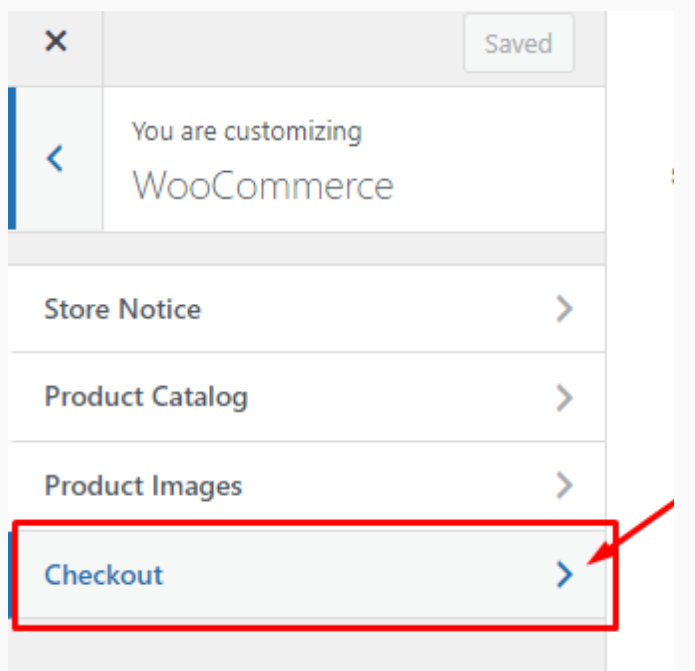
9. From your WordPress dashboard, select **Appearance** and then select **Customize**:



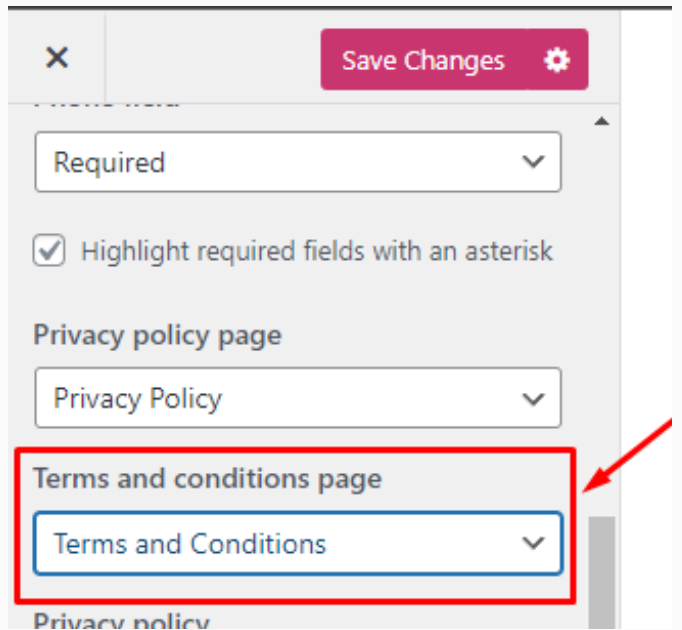
10. When the customizing box opens, choose **WooCommerce**:



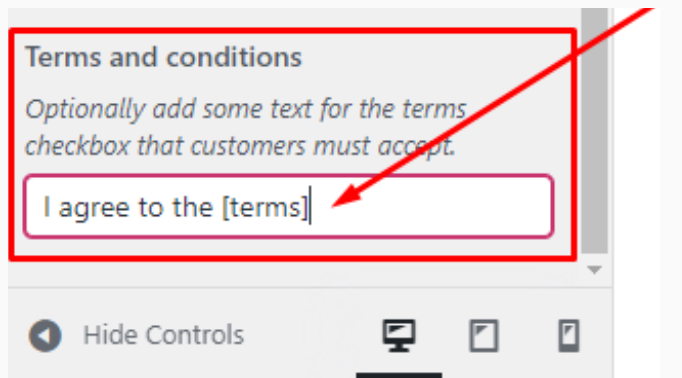
11. Next, select **Checkout** to modify your customer's experience at checkout:



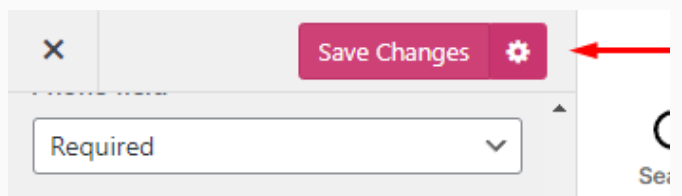
12. Under the **Terms and Conditions page menu**, select the the name of the page you created:



13. Once you add a page here as your Terms and Conditions agreement, WooCommerce will add a checkbox and text that links to the page. If you'd like to edit that text, you can **edit it under Terms and Conditions** and customize it for yourself:



14. When done, click **Save Changes**:
