





How to Add a Cookies Policy on GoDaddy



Steps:


1. Log in to GoDaddy.



2. From the Dashboard, click on **Edit Website**:




When the Website Builder opens, go to Site Menu and click on + to add a new page:



4. In the builder on the right side, type "Cookies Policy" in the Page Title field. Then, click the toggle for Show in Footer and click the Create Page button at the bottom:




 On the newly created Cookies Policy page, click the Add Section button:



 In the Add Section menu, scroll to General > Content. On the right side, choose Ideal for long blocks of text and click the Add button:




7. After the section is added, scroll to the **Title**, **Headline and Description** fields on the right side:





8. Now you need to add text to your Cookies Policy page.


If you do not have a Cookies Policy, you can use our Cookies Policy Generator and create one within minutes.

10. Go back to GoDaddy's Website Builder and title the page as "Cookies Policy." Remove the placeholder text under the Headline field. In the Description field, delete the placeholder text first and then paste the text of your Cookies Policy:
