5. On the newly created Terms and Conditions page, click the **Add Section** button:



 In the Add Section menu, scroll to General > Content. On the right side, choose Ideal for long blocks of text and click the Add button:





 After the section is added, scroll to the Title, Headline and Description fields on the right side: 8. Now you need to add text to your Terms and Conditions page.
