For this example, we've used the **Sidebar** menu. Click on the **+ Add a Gadget**:





13. When the Add a Gadget window opens, scroll down and click Pages:

14. The **Configure Page List** window will show. Make sure that **Show this widget** is active. The **Title** field is optional, but it's a good idea to name your list. For example: **Legal**.





15. Under Page List, click Add a New Item:

16. A new window will open. Under the Page name, select the Privacy Policy page you just created. The Page URL field will be filled automatically.
